

HOW TO STYK IT!



1. Surface Prep

Now that you have your Chopstyky Decal, it's time to apply it. Here we go! To get your Chopstyky to stick, the surface needs to be clean, smooth, and dry. Wash the surface using hot water (give the wall time to dry), Finish by wiping the wall down with rubbing alcohol, which should make your wall really clean and ready for application. **For freshly painted walls,** allow at least two weeks for the paint to cure.

Note: Chopstyky decals will not stick to wet walls.



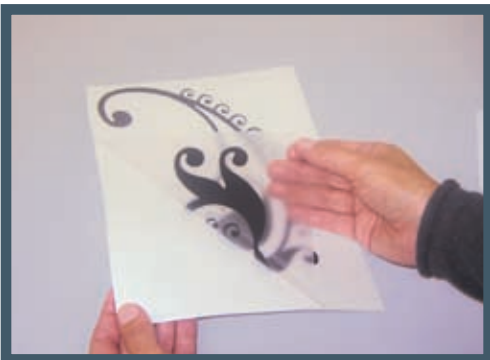
2a. Cut Around it (optional)

Depending on your design, you may wish to cut loosely around the decal in order to move it around with ease. This will allow you to position the individual design elements of your pack where you would like them to be.



2b. Create Your Design

It's time to get creative. We recommend that before you apply your decal, tape it up with masking or painter's tape and move it around to find the layout and design that works best for your wall surface. Be creative and above all: Have Fun! Once you are ready and love what you see, it's time to take the next step.



3. Transfer Prep

Lay your decal, graphic side down onto a hard smooth surface, ie: floor, table, or whatever works best for you. Using the applicator card, or your hand, rub firmly over the entire backing of the decal. Very Slowly now Start to peel away the white backing paper.

Some highly detailed graphics may stick to the backing paper: simply stop peeling, roll back, rub and repress the decal onto the transfer tape. Continue to slowly peel away the backing paper until the decal is completely separated from the backing paper.



4. Sticking it On

With the backing paper completely removed from the decal; gently smooth the graphic onto your surface using the applicator, your hand, or a credit card. Each stroke must overlap the previous one. Work from the center out to avoid air bubbles.

Imagine you are pushing air away from under the vinyl. Never angle the application card toward the centre line, as this may produce bubbles and wrinkles. Always work from the centre outward.

** If your chopstyck decal is large, grab an extra hand! This will make things much easier.*



5. The peel off

Almost Done Now!

To remove the application tape from the graphic, start at one corner, pull the tape against itself at a 180 - degree angle: Do this slowly! If any part of the graphic does not stick to the surface, carefully place the graphic back onto the surface and rub again. After removing the application tape, be sure to re-press all your edges and overlaps, using your finger or thumb.

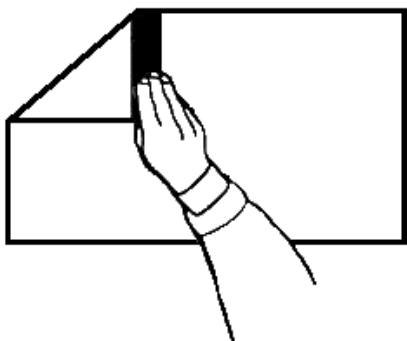


6. Congratulations

You've Done it! Now sit back and enjoy your Chopstyck wall art.

** Bubbling may occur after the graphic decals are applied.*

Simple solution: Take a needle or pin and poke the bubbles that have occurred in order to release the air, then smooth out your decal with your fingers.



7. Ready for a change

Removing vinyl decals is simple. Pick an edge with your finger nail, or tweezers, then slowly peel the decal off your surface as shown.

***The heat of a blow dryer will help soften the vinyl for easier peeling. Make sure the dryer heat is on low.**

If you applied chopstyck decal to a less porous surface i.e. glass: blow-dry on low heat to warm the graphic up. This will help heat the adhesive and make it easier to peel away.

Voila, back to basics.
